



Related Studies in UPCP


- Thesis: The Evaluation of the Preparedness of Pharmacy Students in the Implementation of a Smoking Cessation Program (Florentino, Liban, Pangilinan, Gutierrez)
 - Objective: Evaluate preparedness of graduating pharmacy students in the implementation of a smoking cessation program, by assessing their knowledge on smoking and cessation, and their attitudes on smoking, cessation, and smoking cessation programs.
 - Sample: PACOP-member schools (197 participants 80% response rate)
 - Results:

Preparedness	Not prepared (1.5% passed for knowledge)
Attitude	76% positive attitude towards smoking (?); 94% positive attitude towards smoking cessation
	93% positive attitude towards implementation of smoking cessation program



Related Studies in UPCP

- Perspectives of 4th year UP College of Pharmacy Students on the Integration of Pharmacist-Initiated Smoking Cessation Training as part of Pharmacy 154 Laboratory (Ayran, Baloloy, Tan)
 - Objective: Describe perspective of 4th year BSP and BSIP students on the integration of pharmacist-initiated smoking cessation in their Pharmacy 154 laboratory
 - Results: high level of agreement pharmacists are competent and integration is advantageous
 - Content: (a) background of smoking cessation in the Philippines, (b) use of tools to assess nicotine dependence, (c) use of medical devices for smoking cessation, and (d) behavioral and pharmacological for nicotine dependence



Future Steps for UPCP

- Formulation of herbal product containing Vernonia cinereum (Agas-moro)
- Formulation of Silver Nitrate Mouthwash
- Incorporation in the current curriculum
- Development of Teaching Module for smoking Cessation Program (to propose to PACOP-member schools)
- Standardization of documentation and reporting
- Development of Internship Module/ model for Smoking Cessation Program




